On behalf of the Governing Council, Senate and the University Community, I very warmly welcome you all to this hallowed ground, The Evangel Camp which presently accommodates our fast growing Evangel University, Akaeze as Take-Off Campus.

In keeping with the age long tradition of universities, we have gathered to formally receive our freshmen and women into our intellectual community with a view to the realization of the philosophy of our university. That is to train the total man for total service to the society and the community by producing a totally relevant and committed man for a decent society through inculcating in the students, sound academic knowledge, character building, entrepreneurial skills and culture that shall make them independent and yet relevant in the society.

ADMISSIONS

Evangel University is growing rapidly in tandem with the Academic Brief approved for it by the National Universities Commission (NUC). We have admitted a total number of two hundred and fifty (255) students for the 2018/2019 academic Session. In my address presented on 13th April, 2018, I shared the proposal for the establishment of the College of Health Sciences comprising Departments of Nursing Science, Medical Laboratory Science, Radiography and Radiation Science, Physiotherapy; and Public Health. The NUC

conducted its usual Resource Verification exercise and approved the proposal. Accordingly, a number of the students participating in this matriculation ceremony were admitted into those programmes for the 2018/2019 academic session.

At the May/June 2018, NUC Accreditation exercise the least score for each of the programmes visited was 84%. Our staff recruitment and infrastructure improvement is a continuing exercise.

PERMANENT SITE DEVELOPMENT

The Proprietors of the University have signed the Contract for the development of the Permanent Site at Akaeze. Work is expected to start there in the second quarter of 2019. A parcel of land measuring approximately 302 hectares has been acquired and fenced in ready for development of academic buildings and community infrastructure. We covet the prayers of all our stakeholders for the success of the project.

DISCIPLINE

Let me inform our dearly beloved freshmen and women that we believe in the biblical provision that rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft and stubbornness is as iniquity of idolatry. All our RULES are meant to be kept. Attendance to Chapel services at the stipulated time is sacrosanct and it forms part of the Academic Regulations of the University. We do not make pretences about our strict observance of no smoking, no alcoholic beverage consumption, smoking, sexual immorality, fighting, to name but a few. Cooking is not permitted in the hostels and adequate provisions are made at the Common Rooms for use of appliances that require high electric energy. Dress codes are strictly enforced and the governing authorities of the university will not spare any student that goes contrary to these rules.

SECURITY AND SAFETY ON CAMPUS

Adequate provisions have been made to provide security of life and property on campus. More Patrolmen have been recruited to safeguard life and property. The Security Department has been instructed to keep their men at the Enugu-Abakaliki Expressway Junction till 10.00pm daily. Students should endevour to return to the Campus on or before 10.00pm to avoid attack of hoodlums who waylay people at the Expressway Junction. Students are advised to limit shuttles out of the campus for safety reasons. Plans are being perfected to have a Police Check Point at the Expressway Junction.

ACADEMIC STANDARDS

The University shall strive to not only maintain the present academic standards set from inception but to continually seek to improve on them with a view to working towards ranking among the best four universities in Nigeria at our 15th Founder's Day Celebration. Our Library has been equipped with eResources which are available in real time. Internet services are available at no extra cost to all registered students and staff. We have structured standby power provision in the academic areas to run from 9.00am to 4.00pm and the hostel areas from 4.00pm to 12.00 midnight. Students are encouraged to take advantage of these to work very hard to justify the investments being made on them.
